IVA delivers a Bible-based academic program aligned with state and national standards, including core coursework, college preparatory courses, Advanced Placement (AP), Honors, and NCAA-approved coursework. Dual enrollment is available through Cedar Crest College. Instruction is delivered through a flexible, self-paced virtual classroom under certified teacher supervision.

Transcript Interpretation

- IVA operates on a semester-based academic model.
- Semester courses earn 0.5 credit; full-year courses earn 1.0 credit.
- Graduation requires 22 total credits; a minimum of 6 credits must be earned through IVA.
- Accepted transfer courses appear on the official IVA transcript and are included in the cumulative GPA.
- Up to 16 transferred credits may be applied toward graduation requirements.
- GPA is calculated using an unweighted 4.0 scale. Honors and AP courses are not weighted.
- Class rank is not calculated; IVA is a non-ranking school.
